In early January 1875, the small band of four Presentation sisters who had only recently arrived from Ireland moved to the village of Key West just outside the city of Dubuque. The house had been built to be the residence of the pastor but he gave the home to the sisters so they could have both a living space and a school. Within the first days the bishop visited and knowing that there was no market nearby he brought a generous store of meat for the small community. Thoughtful neighbors supplied other offerings of friendship, such as fresh bread. The annals of those early days remark, "Many names are lovingly remembered at this distant day of those who sought by kind acts to help out the little band of missionaries."

Today, our "band of missionaries" continues to remember your kind acts of assistance. We have all seen many changes in the past years, but the consistent generosity of you, our donors, has been grace and gift to the Presentation community. Your

financial contributions, your donations of fresh garden produce, tasty delights, beautiful flower arrangements and supportive prayer continue that spirit of kindness begun 150 years ago. We can never express our thanks enough.

In our Chapter of 2022, sisters and associates re-committed to listening especially to the struggles of creation and to women and children who live in poverty. Active listening calls for an open heart and so we also committed to deepening our listening skills with intentional efforts to change ourselves both communally and individually. Please pray for us as we live into our commitments. Your assistance and accompaniment in these times of change are as valuable in these days as they were in the past. RANDY ENGLER, *Director of Maintenance*

When I started at the Presentation Sisters in 1985, I was the only maintenance person. At that time, we had a steam boiler system and it was required by law that a maintenance person be on the grounds 24/7, so my family lived on the property. Novices primarily took care of the grounds. There were many novices when I started – one year there were nine! They would mow the grass, do all the trimming and many sisters would plant flowers and pull weeds. I was to maintain the buildings and do the plowing.

Today, we have four maintenance employees, three of whom are full-time. The outdoor property and homes on the property require more care. Some sisters plant and mow, but the majority of the property is the maintenance department's responsibility as many sisters are not as agile as they once were. I enjoy working here and of course I like working with the sisters, that is why I have been here 38 years.

Each sister was given charges; this meant they were in charge of different areas and responsibilities within the motherhouse. We only had one car at the motherhouse and a driver would take us from one place to another. If we were living outside of the motherhouse serving in ministry, we took care of ourselves. We did not have our own cars to drive, so we relied on others. At that time, we would have never dreamed of hiring for these jobs or having our own vehicles to get us where we needed to go. When people were hired to work for the Presentation Sisters and as the sisters purchased cars for the community, we, as sisters, could have time to focus more on the mission. Today, I am over 102 years old. I am grateful to have people hired to take care of me and our space.

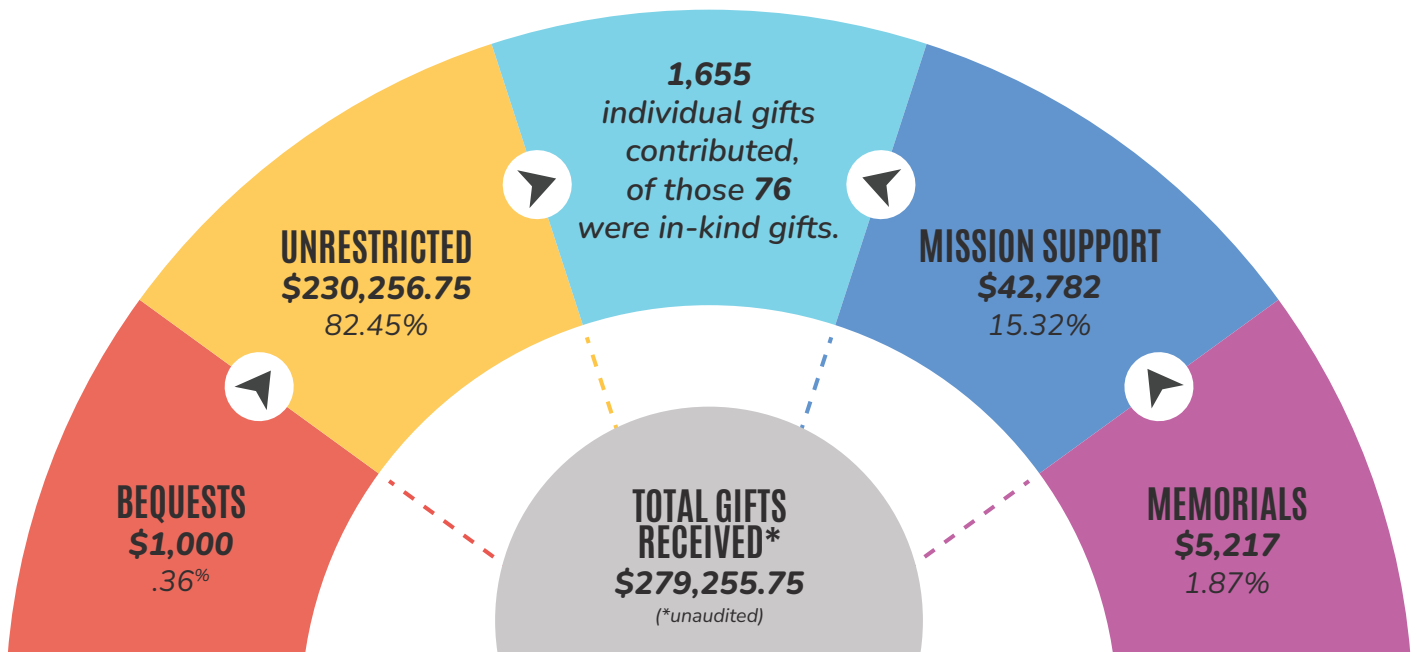

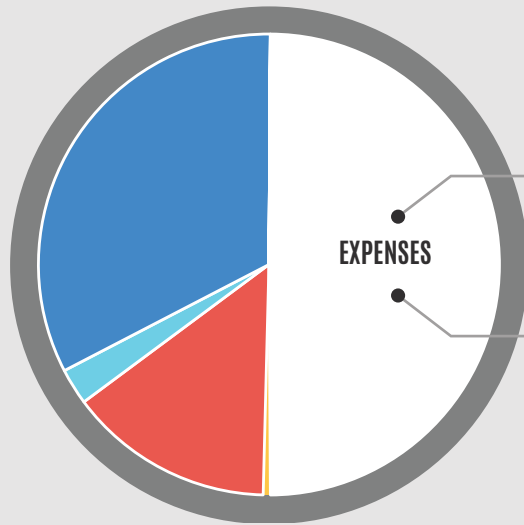

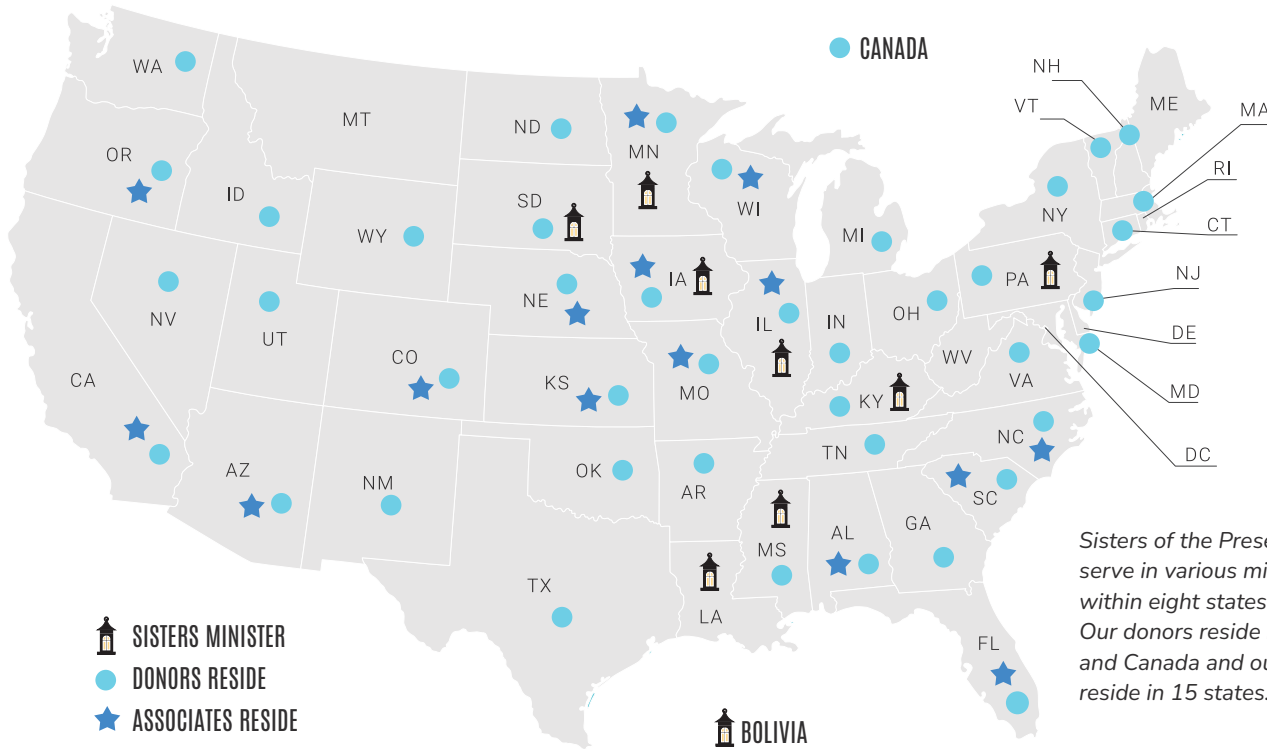
