- How do you think Nano would respond to social injustices and minister to people in need in the world today? How do you think Nano understood her purpose and place in life?
- How does Nano's story call and challenge us today in our personal lives? In our faith communities? The larger Church? Our world community?

Nano Nagle Declared Venerable

On October 31, 2013, Nano Nagle was declared Venerable by Pope Francis. This announcement brings the Canonization of Nano Nagle one step closer as it is the second of four stages in the Canonization Process. Nano Nagle's Cause for Canonization was officially initiated at the bi-centenary of her death in 1984. In 2004, the Central Leadership Team set up a Nano Nagle Commission Office, to help in promoting Nano as a woman of faith and courage, in the hope that she may soon be declared Venerable. The Commission comprises three Presentation Sisters, one from each Irish Province. The Commission has worked to make Nano better known and to promote the Cause of her Canonization. To forward the Cause of Nano, it is imperative that people cultivate devotion to her, and pray to her for favors. (Sisters of the Presentation website www.dbqpbvms.org)
