The principle of hospitality in the Gospels and reflected in the Rule of St. Benedict inspires the Sisters of the Presentation to live with open hearts. In 2024, we reflected on our call to practice radical hospitality – an invitation to transform both ourselves and the world through love, empathy, and generosity. Our focus embraced four pillars, as mentioned in the 2023 Annual Appeal. **These pillars emphasize that true hospitality to others begins with hospitality to ourselves, extending to women and children, and our Earth.**

At the heart of our mission is prayer and a deep spiritual life, which fuel our response to global needs. Personal transformation through education and prayer expresses hospitality to ourselves and prepares us to extend care to others. Hospitality to others follows Nano Nagle's example of welcoming the vulnerable and addressing systemic challenges.

Hospitality to women and children remains central to our vision. Your support – through financial contributions, in-kind gifts and prayer – empowers us to address issues like poverty, food scarcity, homelessness, human trafficking and abuse. Together, we accompany those facing unjust realities with compassion and advocacy.

We also reflected on our hospitality to Earth and how we could assume responsibility. As stewards of creation, we acted on needs we could fulfill, including adding solar energy, planting prairie grasses and collaborating with St. Isidore Catholic Worker Farm in Cuba City, Wisconsin, by assisting on the farm and learning how to care for farmland and animals.





It’s heartwarming to hear someone say, ‘Thanks for helping me!’ or ‘You helped me last time!’ Sometimes, they share pieces of their lives, and I simply listen. These moments of connection are deeply meaningful and transformative.


